


# Palm Sunday, Holy Week and Easter

## **Stations of the Cross | MONDAY 29 March, 8pm | IN CHURCH ONLY**

A devotional and reflective tradition in Holy Week. Using images, bible readings, poetry and music we travel with Jesus on his final journey to the cross. Reflective, moving and profound.

## **Maundy Thursday, 1 April ON ZOOM**

**Service | 8pm** A powerful and moving service where we remember Jesus' last supper with his friends. At the centre of this service is Jesus' example of servant-hearted love.

**The Watch | 9-10pm** From in the side chapel, gathered on Zoom, we will keep watch with Jesus, remembering his time in the Garden of Gethsemane, using a mix of silence, readings & prayers.

## **Good Friday | 2 April**


**At the foot of the Cross: OUTSIDE CHURCH** A large cross will be set up in front of the porch. We're inviting everyone and anyone to walk up the hill that day **anytime from 10am-11am** and lay a stone (plain or decorated) at the foot of the cross, symbolising all that burdens them and all for whom they'd like to pray. The stones will then become a heart sculpture in church on Easter Sunday.

## **1.30-3pm Good Friday Liturgy IN CHURCH & INSTAGRAM**

A reflective service with music, readings, silence and art where we reflect on Jesus' death on the cross.

## **Holy Saturday Easter Vigil | 3 APRIL, 8pm IN CHURCH ONLY**

This service begins with an Easter fire outside, followed by candlelit procession and an intimate service of readings, reflections & an opportunity to renew our baptism vows.
